

Hello Pst Mike,

Agape Care Net was formed officially after being inspired by Kim Sandberg and Ben Edwards of API USA in their trainings here in Kenya. They inspired me on how I can stand to speak for the unborn. So far we have heard great stories in our community Majengo and its environs. Majengo has a population of 90,000 and young people account to more than 50,000.

Most of our clients are young pregnant women who have been left with their boyfriends and also chased from home by their parents. Among them is Caro Makungu who was in form two when she got pregnant. Her boyfriend after learning that Caro was pregnant ran away leaving Caro who was forced to leave home by her parents. Fortunately we had an opportunity to counsel her when she was considering having an abortion at home which is a risky and dangerous practice that has taken away many girls here at the slums in Majengo. She decided to keep the pregnancy, but after delivering her baby boy Travis she found out that she is HIV positive. So far she desires so much to go to school and just to have a means for meals and for herself and her son. Despite harsh conditions she thanks God so much for Agape Care Net.

We also have been able to counsel and provide abortion recovery sessions to some of our clients who were so guilty and now free and thanking God. Also the drug addicts are getting counsel in our office. Due to this great work we now have 22 invitations to schools to teach on smart life. We pray that the Lord will provide resources for transportation and printing of materials to provide to these schools. This is a great opportunity to reach schools with the gospel. In our office we use our personal phones to schedule appointments. Facebook has been also another way of us reaching to the community to schedule appointments and also teach young people on reproductive health and the value of sanctity of life.

So far due to limited resources that we have, request your prayers to the Lord that He should use us continually to speak boldly for the unborn, for God to help us with meals, school fees, sanitary pads and office equipments like a phone, a computer and copier/printer for effective work, good storage and proper communication in order to reach many.

We also pray that since the work is increasing, we request for capacity building (more training) and materials and a means to help our volunteers to reach many schools and churches. So far we have four people who volunteer for 3 days a week. That is Mourine, my wife, Faith, Addah, Clinton, Ted and myself.
